

A New Text from Ur III dynasty on Ba'aga, the fattener

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Abstract:

This Text is one of the new confiscated texts kept in the Iraq Museum of (IM.235869) its measurement (12,7 x 6 x 2,5 cm.) which contains barley delivery, dated to Ur III dynasty (2012-2004 B.C) and the date formulae on this text belongs the (3th) year of the reign of king Ibbi-Suen (2028-2004 B.C), the main figure mentioned in this text is (Ba'aga fattener) from Iri-saḡrig, and comparing it with the published cuneiform texts that belong to his archive they are (196) texts including his activities from AS7 to IS3.

نص جديد من سلالة أور الثالثة عن باأكا مسمن الماشية

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الملخص:

يعد هذا النص أحد النصوص المسمارية المصادرة التي بحوزة المتحف العراقي، ويحمل الرقم المتحف (٢٣٥٨٦٩)، قياساته (١٢,٧ x ٦ x ٢,٥ سم). يتضمن مدخولات كميات من الشعير، أرخ النص الى عصر أور الثالثة (٢٠١٢-٢٠٠٤ ق.م) و يعود الى السنة الثالثة من حكم الملك أبي-سين (٢٠٢٨-٢٠٠٤ ق.م)، أن الشخصية الرئيسية في هذا النص هو (با-أ-كا مسمن الماشية) من مدينة أري-ساكر، ومقارنته مع النصوص المسمارية المنشورة التي تعود الى أرشيفه يبلغ عددها (١٩٦) نصاً تضمنت نشاطاته من السنة السابعة من حكم الملك أمار-سين والى السنة الثالثة من حكم الملك أبي-سين.

Introduction:

The name Ba'aga the fattener (kurušda) was documented in several economic texts form archive of Iri-saḡrig (Al-Šarrakī). Most of these texts likely relate to the same individual during Ur III dynasty (2012-2004 B.C). Most of these texts are published in series (Nisaba 15-2, CUSAS 40-2, CUSAS 3), as well as thesis and dissertations in Iraqi Universities: Baghdad, Mosul, Al-Qadisiyah and Saladin.

Commentary:

Obv:

2-^{lu2} Ba-ši₂-me^{ki}: means man of Bašime, the site located (7 km) from the Iran-Iraq border (Hussein, 2010, p. 48).

3-a-ma-an-i₃-li₂: is the royal messenger, and well known at Iri-saḡrig (CUSAS40/2, N.1570).

7-e-ma-ma: This name appeared in only one AS9 at Iri-saḡrig archive as a (overseer of 10) (Nisaba 15/2, N.164), and the name is attested in Grisus texts in Š46 as a (overseer) (Gomi, 1982, N.56).

11-tu-ra-am-i₃-li₂: is well known at Iri-saḡrig (Garfinkle S. , 2000, p. 33).

12-bala:palû, means “tax” (Sharlach, 2004, p. 16).

13-a-li₂-ni-su: this name is well known at Iri-sağrig (Nisaba 15/2,N.37).

14-mur-gu₄: imrû, means “fodder” (Von Soden, 1972, p. 379).

19-šu-nu-a: the ox scribe, this is the first time in this article IS3.He is attested in one undated text at Iri-sağrig šu-nu-a, and seal impression šu-nu-a scribe son e₂-zi, he received barley from lulu (Nisaba 15/2,N.1045).

21-i₃-dub: išpikû, the term means “storage, produce (of a field)” (CAD I&J p, 258).

an-za-gar₃^{ki}: the name of location (Edzard, 1974, p. 12).

dingir-su-sipa: the name is attested in only two ŠS5 and in IS4 with title (šabra) at Iri-sağrig may be the same individual (Nisaba 15/2,N.351,258).

Rev:

1- i₇-ta-bi₂-ma-ma: the canal is located on Tigris river ,the distance is (31 km) between Iri-sağrig and the inlet of this canal (Molina.M, 2013, p. 70).

4-e₂-duru₅:edurû, the term means “hamlet, village”(CAD E,p.39).

9-gana₂-gu₄: the term means “field plowed by an ox (Nisaba15/2,p.373).

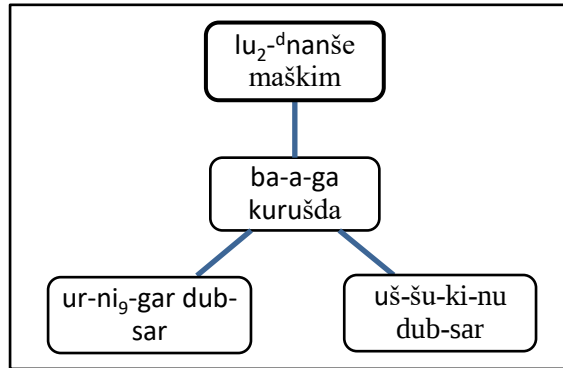
Ba’aga’s identity and family:

Ba’aga is a common name in many Iri-sağrig texts from Ur III dynasty, which appears from AS7 to IS3. Most of these attestations likely relate to the same individual and location. The name is attested as well in Puzirš-Dagan (Drehem) in AS4 (Widell, 2005, p. 18) and ŠS8 (Keiser,1971,N.391). Ba’aga is known in administrative texts from Girsu Š45, as a son of (lu₂-nanše the commissioner): ba-a-ga dumu lu₂-^dnanše maškim (Sollberger, 1976, p. 436), may be is the same individual. (Fig. 1)

He has two sons, as appeared on the impression seals and texts published in this archive’s texts. They were associated with scribe profession:

1-ur-nigar dub-sar (Nisaba15/2:N.59,136,314,385,435): appeared on impression seals from ŠS7 to IS1.

2-uš-šu-kinu dub-sar (Nisaba15/2:N.47,606,1107): appeared on impression



seals in IS1, and he is attested in one text dated to ŠS9 in this archive as a conveyer the scribe (ḡiri₃ uš-šu-kinu dub-sar) (Ahmed, 2020, p. 64).

Ba'aga's activities during Ur III dynasty:

He participated in many different activities, including receiving animals (Garfinkle) mentioned that ba'aga was himself an entrepreneur with the Iri-saḡrig community (Garfinkle, 2012, p. 248). Ba'aga's role was clear in from 7AS to 3IS and it appears that he has working links with a group whose names are constantly repeated in the texts of this archive, including their types:

1-ba-a-ga kurušda i₃-dab₅: His dealings with this type are documented by about (109) texts (Table 2) receiving animals from shepherds, grooms, scribes, merchants, archivists, administrators, hunters and gardeners under the supervision of officials such as observers and conveyors.

2-ba-a-ga kurušda šu-ba-ti:Ba'aga attested in (6) texts receiving barley and mills from individuals,adlal the scribe,and ašgialsu.these texts were dated to the 5ŠS and 3IS.

3-ki ba-a-ga kurušda-ta:He has been documented in (53) texts delivering animals and their carcasses,as well as barley,to people including šumma,whose name appears repeatedly within (10) texts.this collection is dated from the 7AS to 9AS.

4-ba-a-ga kurušda zi-ga:Ba'aga has been documented in (19) texts who expenses a variety of item,beer,soup,and lard to female millers in the feedlot.these texts date from 7AS to 1IS.

5-ugula ba-a-ga kurušda :he has been attested in (6) texts,including one of which was receipt of pigs by nuḫilum (the shepherd of pigs).the texts are dated from 4ŠS to 1IS.

6-ḡiri₃ ba-a-ga kurušda:He is documented in one text as a conveyor of animals received by urmes (the ruler) from aḫuwer,dating the text in 5ŠS.

7-nig₂-ka₉-ak ba-a-ga kurušda:This type of documents includes the accounts of the ba'aga (the fattener) and by šueštar (steward,animal conveyor).dating the two texts in the 4ŠS and 9ŠS.

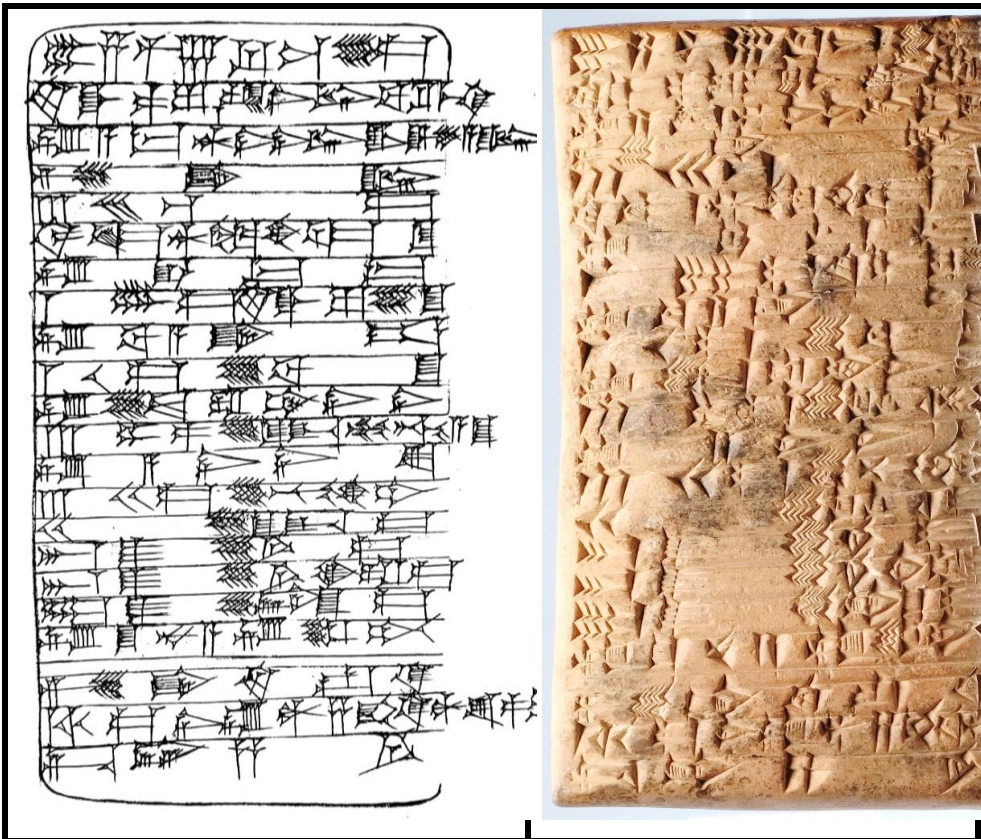

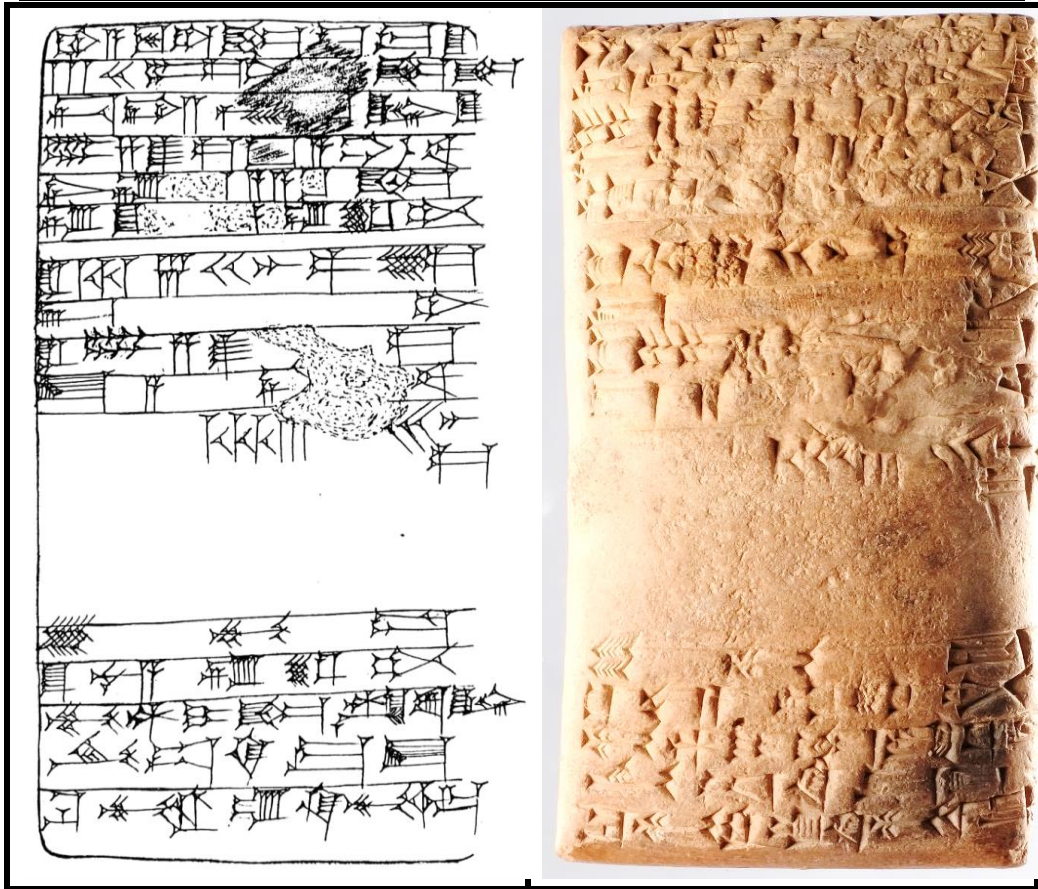

Conclusions:

It is clear from ba'aga's archive (the fattener kurušda) whose published texts are about (196) texts, may be he is responsible for an organization, bureau or pen in Iri-sağrig because of his several dealings with many individuals such as shepherds, grooms, observers and stewards as well as assisting his sons Urnigar (the scribe) and Šuškinu (the scribe). Ba'aga (the fattener) appeared from 7AS to 3IS. He associated with other professions in addition to his main profession including the observer (ugula) and the conveyer (ğiri₃).
